Clause 1 – Agreement to Sell and Purchase

The Seller agrees to sell and the Buyer agrees to purchase the Goods described herein pursuant to the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

Clause 2 – Goods Description and Condition

The Goods are sold as described above and are accepted by the Buyer in their current condition. The Seller makes no other representations or warranties except as expressly set out in this Agreement.

Clause 3 – Purchase Price and Payment

The total purchase price for the Goods is the amount specified above. Payment shall be made in full by the Buyer according to the agreed payment method and schedule.

Clause 4 – Delivery and Risk

The Goods shall be delivered to the Buyer at the location agreed upon by the parties. Risk of loss or damage shall pass to the Buyer upon delivery.

Clause 5 – Title and Ownership

Title and ownership of the Goods shall pass to the Buyer upon receipt of full payment.

Clause 6 – Warranties

The Seller warrants that they have good and marketable title to the Goods and that the Goods are free from any liens or encumbrances.

Clause 7 – Inspection and Acceptance

The Buyer has the right to inspect the Goods prior to completing the purchase and accepts the Goods as-is based on such inspection.

Clause 8 – Default

If either party fails to perform their obligations under this Agreement, the non-defaulting party may terminate this Agreement and seek any remedies available at law or in equity.

Clause 9 – Limitation of Liability

Neither party shall be liable for any indirect, incidental, or consequential damages arising out of or in connection with this Agreement.

Clause 10 – Confidentiality

Both parties agree to keep confidential any non-public information received in connection with this Agreement.

Clause 11 – Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales.

Clause 12 – Jurisdiction

The parties submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales for any disputes arising out of or in connection with this Agreement.

Clause 13 – Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations, understandings and agreements.

Clause 14 – Amendments

Any amendments to this Agreement must be made in writing and signed by both parties.

Clause 15 – Notices

All notices under this Agreement shall be in writing and deemed properly served if delivered by hand, post, or electronic communication to the addresses provided.

Clause 16 – Force Majeure

Neither party shall be liable for failure or delay in performance due to causes beyond their reasonable control.

Clause 17 – Severability

If any provision of this Agreement is found to be unenforceable, the remainder shall continue in full force and effect.

Clause 18 – Waiver

Failure to enforce any provision of this Agreement shall not constitute a waiver of future enforcement of that or any other provision.

Clause 19 – Counterparts

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original.

Clause 20 – Signatures

This Agreement is executed by the parties as of the date first written above.
