Clause 1 – Purpose of Agreement

This Agreement is made between the Parties to determine the arrangements for the upbringing of the Child(ren) named herein. It is intended to be legally binding and enforceable under the law of England and Wales.

Clause 2 – Custody and Residence

The Child(ren) shall reside primarily with Parent/Guardian 1 and the Parties agree to share parental responsibility. Specific arrangements for residence, including days and times, shall be agreed and set out herein.

Clause 3 – Contact and Communication

Parent/Guardian 2 shall have reasonable contact with the Child(ren) as agreed by the Parties, including in-person visits, telephone calls, video calls, and written communication. The Parties agree to facilitate and encourage positive contact.

Clause 4 – Education

The Parties shall mutually agree on all matters relating to the education of the Child(ren), including school choice, attendance at meetings, and educational support.

Clause 5 – Health and Medical Care

The Parties shall make joint decisions regarding the health and medical care of the Child(ren). Both Parties shall have access to medical records and shall inform each other promptly of any significant health matters.

Clause 6 – Religious and Cultural Upbringing

The Child(ren)'s religious and cultural upbringing shall be decided jointly by the Parties, respecting the Child(ren)'s best interests and welfare.

Clause 7 – Holidays and Special Occasions

The Parties shall agree on arrangements for the Child(ren)'s time during school holidays, public holidays, birthdays, and other special occasions, ensuring fair and reasonable sharing.

Clause 8 – Dispute Resolution

In the event of disagreement on any matter arising under this Agreement, the Parties agree to attempt mediation or other forms of alternative dispute resolution before pursuing court proceedings.

Clause 9 – Changes to the Agreement

Any changes to this Agreement must be made in writing and signed by both Parties. The Parties acknowledge that circumstances may change and agree to review this Agreement as needed in the best interests of the Child(ren).

Clause 10 – Confidentiality

The Parties agree to keep the details of this Agreement and any related proceedings confidential, except where disclosure is required by law or agreed by both Parties.

Clause 11 – Legal Advice

Each Party confirms that they have had the opportunity to seek independent legal advice regarding this Agreement and fully understand its terms and legal effect.

Clause 12 – Entire Agreement

This document constitutes the entire Agreement between the Parties concerning the matters herein and supersedes all prior discussions, representations, or agreements.

Clause 13 – Governing Law and Jurisdiction

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the law of England and Wales. The Parties submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales for any disputes arising under this Agreement.

Clause 14 – Signatures and Execution

This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument. Electronic signatures shall be deemed valid.

Clause 15 – Parental Responsibility

Both Parties confirm that they have parental responsibility for the Child(ren) and agree to act in their best interests at all times.

Clause 16 – Safety and Welfare

The Parties agree to take all necessary steps to protect the safety and welfare of the Child(ren) during the exercise of any rights under this Agreement.

Clause 17 – Review and Variation

The Parties agree to review the arrangements periodically and to vary this Agreement by mutual consent to reflect changes in circumstances.

Clause 18 – Non-Harassment

The Parties agree not to harass or intimidate each other or the Child(ren) and to promote a respectful and cooperative relationship.

Clause 19 – Interim Arrangements

Pending any future review or court order, the Parties shall abide by the terms of this Agreement and cooperate fully to facilitate its operation.

Clause 20 – Additional Provisions

Any additional provisions or special conditions agreed by the Parties are set out in the attached Schedule(s), which form part of this Agreement.
