Duration and Variation:

This Agreement shall remain in effect until each child reaches the age of 18 years or completes full-time education, whichever occurs later. Either party may request a review or variation of this Agreement in accordance with applicable UK law and Child Maintenance Service guidelines.

Responsibilities of the Parties:

1. The Payor shall make maintenance payments punctually and in full as specified. 2. The Recipient shall use payments for the benefit and welfare of the child(ren). 3. Both parties shall keep each other informed of any changes in circumstances that may affect this Agreement. 4. The Payor shall provide reasonable access to the child(ren) consistent with existing arrangements or court orders.

Review and Variation Procedures:

Either party may request a variation of the maintenance amount or terms subject to statutory provisions and procedures. Requests should be made in writing and supported by relevant evidence of change in financial circumstances or needs of the child(ren). If the parties cannot agree on variation, application to the Child Maintenance Service or Family Court may be made.

Confidentiality:

All personal and financial information shared between the parties under this Agreement shall be treated as confidential and used solely for the purposes of enforcing and administering this Agreement, except as required by law or professional advisors.

Dispute Resolution:

The parties agree to attempt to resolve any disputes arising out of or in connection with this Agreement through mediation or negotiation prior to initiating legal proceedings. This Agreement is governed by the laws of England and Wales.

Termination:

This Agreement shall terminate automatically upon the child(ren) reaching the age of 18 years or completion of full-time education. Early termination or variation may occur only by mutual written consent or by court order.

Legal Effect and Enforceability:

This Agreement constitutes a legally binding contract between the parties. The parties acknowledge they have read, understood, and agreed to all terms herein. It is recommended that each party seek independent legal advice prior to execution. If any provision is found unenforceable, the remainder shall continue in full force and effect.

Miscellaneous:

1. This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original. 2. Amendments or waivers must be in writing and signed by both parties. 3. Notices under this Agreement shall be given in writing in accordance with contact details above.
